

Current Paediatric Critical Care Training Provision (Network Wide) Correct as of September 2023

Paediatric Critical Care (PCC) training is both the responsibility of the provider and the South Thames Paediatric Network (GIRFT 2022). Below is a table of all Critical Care Education provided Network wide for providers to access, with clear definitions of the target audience for each. There are also diagrams for recommended Nursing and Medical staff training.

STPN Responsibility

- Provide appropriate access to PICS-E approved Level 1&2 Course
- LTV course access
- Resources to support local PCC training
- Webinars related to PCC
- Surge planning training
- Reactive training

Provider Responsibility

- Access courses appropriately, escalating any concerns to the Network
- Access training provided by South Thames Retrieval service
- Use resources as required and expertise within the providers to run local training and updates including regular simulations and shared learning from events across the Multi-disciplinary team related to Paediatric Critical Care
- Keep an accurate record of training provided and courses attended




Nursing: Essential PCC training recommendations
